

Update on Masks at Manor Church

Christlike compassion and understanding continue to be essential qualities for all our interaction with others. With such a variety of perspectives, ages, vulnerabilities, and health concerns, thank you for being Christlike to demonstrate love for one another all throughout these transitions.

If you are fully vaccinated, wearing a mask while inside Manor Church facilities is optional. While you do not need to wear a mask if you are fully vaccinated, please keep a mask with you. If you are having a conversation with someone who is masked, it is kind to ask if the person would be more comfortable if you wear a mask while together. When in the presence of a person (or a group of people) you believe may be extra-vulnerable or incapable of discerning their own risk, please defer to wearing a mask.

We also ask that if you are *not* fully vaccinated, please continue to wear a mask. This is for your protection and for the safety of others.

Parents should use their own discernment regarding whether or not their children/students wear masks. For the present, all children/youth workers will be wearing masks when involved in their various ministries to youth.

For the present, we will be continuing distanced seating using blue tape in the auditorium, with the understanding that friends and family may use their own best discernment regarding seating. Such distancing will be regularly reviewed and potentially revised on an ongoing basis.

As per our normal health guidelines, anyone that is sick, has had a fever within 24 hours, or that has potentiality been exposed to a contagious illness, should stay away from others outside their immediate family.
