Review and discuss these key thoughts from previous weeks in the series:

- Take stock of your stuff. Ask yourself - Do your possessions possess you?
- Start or restart regular rhythms of giving and sharing.
- Put your giving in your budget—first place!
- Think BIG. Not how much do I have to give; how much do I GET to give?
- Constantly open your heart to see & hear stirrings toward justice, mercy, and faith! Get involved, you know - hands-on difference-making.
- Focus on Jesus' great giving!
- We are accountable to God for his stuff.
- We will be commended and rewarded for handling God's resources with urgency and proactive planning.
