Our teaching focus today ponders this Q: Who is Jesus really—his character, his heart, and his potential influence?

Read <u>Luke 19:28-40</u>. What are your top four or five personal observations? What stands out to you about this unique scene and Jesus' character?

Give additional focus to <u>vs. 39-40</u>. What's the Pharisees' tone and issue? What's Jesus' response and why?

Recall one of your favorite characters from a favorite book or movie. What was complex about her/his character?

Read **Exodus 34:6-7**. What do you learn about God's wondrous complexity?

Return to Luke 19, now focusing on <u>vs. 41-44</u>.

What further insights do these verses show us about Jesus' heart?

For bonus insights, explore **John 11:30-46**. What do you learn about Jesus' heart and character?

Compose a personal response to Jesus in heart-felt prayer, in light of the robust mix that makes up his heart.

How will you respond to him today and heading into Holy Week?
