Pull out the top 4 or 5 extra-meaty, marvelous words Paul uses, your favorites. What do they mean?

Ponder this key idea: *Christ transforms us from WRONG to RIGHT. Trust him and tell others!*

How do you see this described in Romans 3?

Are you genuinely trusting Christ right now? If so, how and why? If not, why not?

What might you be wrestling with in your heart and mind related to Christ?

What will an even more active, growing faith look like in the coming season of your life?

How will you personally apply the truths you've picked up on Romans 3?
