- Belonging in Jesus' circle means we live in the power of the Holy Spirit (vs. 14-15).
- Belonging in Jesus' circle means we receive and proclaim Gospel—good news that restores the broken (vs. 16-21).
- Belonging in Jesus' circle means we're amazed at grace (vs. 22-24).
- Belonging in Jesus' circle means we welcome everyone—especially those religion resists (vs. 25-30).
